

PLAYER SELECTION PROCESS

Selections for each team are a process that contains the main different components:

- All current FD players have been evaluated by their current coach and director from the previous season. These year-long evaluations have been compiled and organized for the current tryout.
- Tryout performance by new players and current FD players. Coaches will look at the pool of players and evaluate the tryout performance for all players.
- Attitude and effort of all players.

TEAM FEES

Depending upon age level and playing level, each team will have separate team expenses/fees which are not covered in club registration fees. These expenses/fees may include the following:

- Tournament registration fees
- Bus/Van and Hotel expenses for players
- Travel expenses for the coaching staff
- State Cup/ Region Cup fees
- Referee fees for non-league games
- Special team events

Your coach or Team Manager will provide information regarding any team expenses for the season and those fees will be collected separately from club registration fees.

UNIFORMS

Competitive uniforms are not included in the registration fees and are purchased in 2-year cycles. FD Football Club is an exclusive (*To be released soon*) member and uniforms are ordered online through (*to be released soon*) by each family. An email will be sent to you regarding uniform ordering instructions in June.

PLAYER & PARENT EXPECTATIONS

It is a joint effort between players, parents/guardians, coaches, administrators, and the club to provide everyone with a positive experience – beyond just soccer.

WHAT TO EXPECT

COMMUNICATION

- Expect we will do our best to communicate with you.
- Expect regular communication from the Directors and coaches.
- Expect to receive information about FD Football Club events & programs.
- Expect to have any concerns addressed.

TRAINING

- Expect to receive quality training in a positive, learning environment.
- Expect us to uphold our goal to improve your child's skills, their understanding of the game, their physical development, and their growth as children.

GAMES

- Expect the coach to attend games or obtain proper coverage for the games.
- Expect an age-appropriate instruction game.

TOURNAMENTS

- Coaches work with Directors to decide on appropriate tournaments for each team.
- We represent FD Football Club at tournaments.

COACHES

- Expect your child's coach to be a leader and role model for your child.
- Expect your coach to help your child to grow as a person and in their love of the game.
- Expect your coach to demonstrate good sportsmanship and leadership.
- Expect your coach to be prepared for practices and games.

APPRECIATION

- We appreciate the time and support you put into your child's soccer team and FD Football Club!
- It takes the effort of many people to help players grow in their soccer experience and as children!

FD FOOTBALL CLUB EXPECTATIONS

YOUR CHILD

- Is your child prepared?
- Physically eating properly, sleeping properly
- Mentally excited to play, a full "emotional tank" where they're not worried about mom/dad analyzing their play.
- Technically does your child get out with a ball on their own?
- Watching soccer does your child watch soccer on television?
- Grades is your child balancing soccer with their schoolwork?

COMMUNICATION

- Communicate with the coach about being late or any missed practices (marked on Playmetrics).
- Communicate with the coach about any possible missed games well ahead of the game.
- Parents/guardians are not permitted to approach the coach after the game for discussions about playing time, playing position, complaints, etc. Parents must follow 48 hours rule before scheduling a meeting with the coach.
- Communicate with the coach first about any issues related to your child. If the issue is not being resolved, then contact the Director of Coaching.

TRAINING

- Players are expected to be at practice on time and you are there to pick them up on time.
- Players need to be properly dressed and have water.
- No parents/guardians are permitted on the field at FD Football Club fields. All parents/guardians are to remain behind the fence/lines at each designated park.
- The club expects players' parents/guardians to demonstrate behavior that aligns with the club's core values and beliefs.

GAMES

- Make sure your child is on time.
- Make sure they are prepared physically, mentally.
- Make sure they arrive in the appropriate game-day uniform, always bring both uniforms kits, and bring water (this is something they should ultimately be responsible for).
- Support your child, team, and coach.
- Respect the referees knowing that it could be your child very soon who will make mistakes and should not have adults yelling at them.
- The club expects players' parents/guardians to demonstrate behavior that aligns with the club's core values and beliefs

WEATHER POLICY

- Monitoring weather conditions are the responsibility of the game officials, FD Football Club Directors, and Coaches.
- Everyone should be aware of the potential dangers caused by different weather conditions and we need to work together to keep the players and other participants as safe as possible. If the weather conditions warrant, coaches will discuss before the game/training starts what the procedures will be to ensure the safety of the players.
- Club Directors, Coaches, and game officials will monitor weather conditions including the warnings and watches issued by the National Weather Service.
- In ALL cases, FD Football Club will keep the safety of its players, families, coaches, and all persons as the highest priority.

FINANCIAL POLICIES

The FD Competitive Program is a Full Season Program.

Option 1 - PAY IN FULL

During club registration, families will be able to pay upfront the full season Club Fees.

Option 2 - MONTHLY PAYMENT PLAN

During club registration, a payment plan is offered as a registration fee + 10 equal recurring monthly payments by the 1st of each month beginning in August, 2022 (A 3% convenience fee is applied on the monthly payment plan).

Discounts

• Sibling discount:

Sibling discounts are available to all FD Football Club families. Each of the family members will have a 10% off for the first sibling and 15% off for the second one to the Club fees*

Financial Aid

We are committed to working with families to make soccer affordable for all. We offer payment plans for our players.

FD Football Club provides need-based assistance to those that can demonstrate financial need. Between 2020 and 2022 FD Football Club has given over \$40,000 in financial assistance including scholarships and donations made from local businesses. To determine eligibility for assistance we use the Federal Poverty Thresholds and your household adjusted gross income (AGI).

FD for All is a 501 (c) (3) organization. Please consider making a charitable contribution to this fund to assist families in our community.

The following information is required:

• 1040 Tax return - pages 1 & 2 showing your AGI.

No pay no play policy

Failure to pay fees within thirty (30) days of the due date will result in disciplinary action. The player will not be able to attend either practices or games until all payments and late fees are paid. If you expect payment issues, contact us by email at payments.fdfootballclub@gmail.com for possible alternatives.

Refund

FD Elite Program is a 10 month commitment program. Our refund policy was established to protect team integrity and follow our strict player development guidelines, dictated by our Staff. In the interest of fairness, the additional cost of leaving a team should not be passed on to the other players or affect the organization as a whole. With this in mind, FD Football Club has a limited refund policy. The initial registration fee paid at registration is non-refundable.

TOURNAMENT POLICIES

In addition to league games, FD Football Club Team will work on analyzing and selecting the best tournaments according to the club standards and will invite teams considering the different aspects of the tournaments. FD Football Club teams are required to attend any scheduled tournament by The FD Football Club Team.

- Participation in a tournament as a guest player with an FD Football Club team that is not the player's own will incur charges equal to the amount paid by every other player on the team.
- Families are required to pay the invoice by the established deadline, no later than one week before the tournament start date. Failure to pay the invoice by the deadline could result in the forfeiture of the player's roster spot for the tournament.
- Any family with a pending invoice will result in no invitation for the following tournaments.
- Reimbursement for canceled tournaments will be the full tournament fee minus any costs withheld by the tournament host.
- Any player who knowingly will miss a tournament game must notify the Coach and Team Manager by a deadline of one week prior to the tournament start date.
- Any player who will miss a tournament game due to a game day emergency must notify the Coach and Team Manager as soon as the emergency is known.
- Failure to attend a tournament game could result in limited or no playing time during subsequent games.
- Excused absences for missed tournament games will include player or family emergencies and player medical illness/injury.
